Demonstrations using computers and/or acquisition devices, etc. are best planned for Thursday. We will set up demonstrations and practical exercises as individual stations among which the participants can circulate. For this, there is an equipped lab (overhead lights, Artec Leo/Studio18, Rhino8, etc.), a classroom with PC projector, and ample outdoor space available.

Please register and – should you wish to present – submit your proposed presentation by **20 October 2025**, including title, keywords, lecture/demo, hardware requirements. Registration is simple: just send an email to mht@vikingeskibsmuseet.dk with name, contact info, and the above.

We wish to keep administration to a minimum, so there is no registration fee. However, this means that you should prepare to pay for your meals etc. as we go along, so please bring a valid international credit card and perhaps some local currency.
